

AGREEMENT TO MAKE AND TO ACCEPT GIFT

THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between DR. PATRICIA L. SWENSON ("Donor") and WESTERN WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY, Bellingham, Washington ("Western").

IT IS MADE PURSUANT TO THE FOLLOWING FACTS:

- A. Donor is a single woman, and resides at 2119 NE Wasco Street, Portland, Oregon;
- B. Western is a State-funded institution of higher education located at Bellingham, Washington;
- C. Donor owns a tract of real property at 7071 Yachthaven Road, San Juan Island, Washington, legally described as follows:

Lots 30 and 31, Plat of Yacht Haven, according to the plat recorded in Volume 1 of Plats, page 57, records of San Juan County, Washington; together with tidelands of the second class adjoining.

- D. Donor intends to donate the property to Western as a charitable gift, subject to the restrictions and conditions described in this Agreement, on August 16, 1996. P.L.S.
- E. Western intends to accept the donation of the property, subject to those conditions and restrictions.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Donation. Donor agrees to donate the property to Western. on August 16, 1996 P.L.S.
- 2. Acceptance. Western agrees to accept the donation. P.L.S.
- 3. Conditions. Western agrees to accept and to hold the property subject to the following conditions and restrictions:

(a) Western will never sell or otherwise convey the property, except that if Western determines that it no longer desires to utilize the property as provided in this Agreement, Western will convey the property to the ~~San Juan County Land Trust~~, an organization exempt from taxes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, operating in San Juan County, Washington. If that organization no longer exists, Western will convey the property to

another tax-exempt public charity whose objective is the preservation of natural habitat and scenic property in San Juan County.

(b) The property will be managed by and utilized by Western Washington University for use by faculty and students for research and study.

(c) The property will remain essentially undeveloped in its current state, except that additional facilities may be constructed to support additional research and study activities.

(d) Western may remove some trees, provided that the purpose of such removal is to enhance the site for permitted uses or to provide for safety. The income or proceeds from the sale of such trees shall be deposited in an account at The Western Foundation and restricted to use for the support of the property.

(e) The tidelands are to be protected from all construction, with the possible exception of stairs necessary to reach them.

4. Documentation. Donor shall execute such documents of conveyance as shall be prepared and presented by Western.

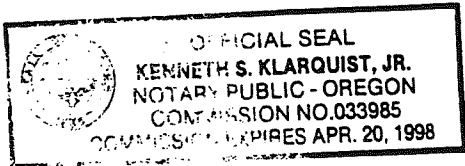
